TCRMF Risk Alert - Eastland Complex Fire and Critical Fire Danger

The danger of wildfire is extreme due to the high winds, drought, and very low humidity. The Eastland complex fire affecting Eastland, Brown, and Comanche counties has burned over 45,000 acres and is not under control as of this afternoon, March 18, 2022. Evacuations have been ordered in Gorman, Carbon, and Lake Leon. Centers should monitor this fire, and any other fire in your area, and its potential impact on center people and facilities. Other large fires are also active in Runnels and Coleman County (7,000 acres) and in other parts of the state.
