### TCRMF Risk Alert

#### Tropical Development in the Gulf

The National Hurricane Center has issued an advisory about a tropical depression that is now in the central Gulf of Mexico. It is expected to develop further and continue moving to the west. The NHC advises that interests in south Texas and northern Mexico pay close attention to this potential tropical storm. Centers should examine their emergency response plans and begin preparations that may include gathering emergency supplies, notifying tropical storm response team members, and making sure vehicles and emergency generators are fully fueled. Remember to move vehicles and equipment, where possible, to locations less prone to flooding.

In addition, there are three named storms in the Atlantic. None of them seem to pose any threat to the Gulf area but this is an indication of the potential for the rest of Hurricane season. Stay alert and contact Fund Risk Control Consultants for any assistance you may need.
