Some of the preventive measures the center had in place prevented a complete takeover, but over 170,000 clients' personal health information was exposed. The center did everything right after the attack was discovered such as responding quickly, engaging professional help, and starting the forensics process to determine where the attack came from and who was exposed by the attack.
